

The twelfth 2019 hike for the Selkirk Purcell Cabinet Group will be next Wednesday July 3<sup>rd</sup> to Clifty (the north facing cliff right above Bonners Ferry).

Departure time will be **8:00AM** from Big Flag Information Center Parking Lot Bonners Ferry and 8:15 from [Twenty Mile Road Parking Lot](#) (North of Blue Lake). Right above Bonners Ferry, from Clifty we will be able to view much of Boundary and Bonner Counties.

The [Clifty Trail](#) is a short (three switchbacks) trail off the Katka trail. We will go out on the Katka trail for ½ mile to the steep meadows, and then come back to go up to Clifty. The whole hike will then be only about 4 miles. Hopefully, our Dr. Jimmy Richardson will brief us on some geological points of interest.
