

Downhill Deer Ridge RD to Ruby Ridge Trail | Purcells

The twenty fifth 2019 hike for our Selkirk Cabinet Purcell Group (Wednesday, October 9th) will be a one-way downhill hike that ends near Feist Creek Restaurant. It starts on the Snyder Creek Trail 205 at the Deer Ridge Road and goes down to Ruby Ridge Trail 35, and then to the end of that trail near Feist Creek. I told the restaurant we are coming for lunch.

We will be looking down at the Moyie Valley and over at Queen Mountain all along the hike. It will be a 5-mile hike that goes down about 2,000 ft. Look at the elevation profile for the path in the Google Earth Files to help decide if you want to go. Just right click on the path.

We will be leaving at **9:00AM** from the [Big Flag Information Center Parking Lot Bonners Ferry](#). If you want to be picked up at the 3Mile, let me know by email at least a day early.
