

The fourth 2017 hike for our Selkirk Cabinet Purcell Group Wednesday May 24<sup>th</sup> will be a low level hike over on the Westside Road to Lost Creek Falls.

The hike is rather short hike with great views of the Valley, with some steepness. Lost Creek comes down from the left side of Burton Peak and flows into the Kootenai Rive at the Peterson Farm in District 3. I put a place marker on the Boundary County Selkirk Fall line, but I cannot see the logging roads Terry Howe says we will switch back up to Lost Creek Falls. He and Chet Savage have been there and say it will be a good hike.

To avoid the cold and fog, we will be leaving a little later on this one: 9:00AM from the [Davidson Farm](#) in District One on Riverside Road 2.3 miles west of the south end of the Bonners Ferry Bridge and the Kootenai River Brewery.
