

Departure for seventh hike of the season next Wednesday August 15, 2012 at 8:00AM from [Pace Home \(7087 Funkhouser St, Bonners Ferry\)](#) or 8:10 from The Davidson Farm in District One (one mile west of Bonners on the River, before the Deep Creek Bridge and the West Side Road).

The [Pyramid Pass Hike](#) is a 2.7 mile hike up from the Trout Creek trailhead which is 25.5 miles from the Zita and Bob Pace Home. Here are some of Our Photos: [2012-08-15 Pyramid Pass Parker Ridge Hike](#).

Here is the [Pyramid Pass Folder](#) of the red Google Earth trail paths descriptions, the route from the Pace Home to the Trout Creek Trailhead (for the Pyramid Pass Hike and all these other Trout Creek hikes), the mountain peaks and lakes in the area, all oriented to how you will see them from the hike.

Here is the route from Sandpoint to (Pace Home) [our departure point 7087 Funkhouser ST](#), Bonners Ferry, ID. On the left just past the Mirror Lake Golf Course and just past the old Deep Creek Loop highway, turn left (West) onto Funkhouser Street at the Dodge Peak Lodge. It is the fourth and last house on the right (the light blue house right before the rust colored house at the end of the road).

The moderate [Pyramid Pass Hike](#) on [Trail 13](#) is 2.7 miles long. Part of the [West Bonners Ferry trail system](#), Trail 13 is the main corridor trail for the Trout Creek area. It ties together trails offering access to [Pyramid, Ball, Trout and Big Fisher lakes](#) plus [Long Canyon](#) and [Parker Ridge](#). So, it will be an easy way for some of us to see if we can do these other great day trips. To do that, check out the elevation profiles in these links. For example, this trail goes up 1,300 feet in two miles. If we have time and energy we may want to go to Pyramid Lake also (3/4 mile from Trail 13), another moderate hike. So, if we skip the back side of Trail 13 and substitute the trail to Pyramid Lake the hike will still be only 2.75 miles one way or 5.5 miles total.

[Trout Creek](#) road comes after the Ball Creek Ranch on the Westside Road, before Parker Creek, [Canyon Creek, Smith Creek and Boundary Creek](#).
