

For the Selkirk, Cabinet, Purcell hiking group, the fifth hike for 2015 will be Wednesday, May 6th to Beaver Lake from the old Shiloh Ranger Station. It will be another low level hike, but a little longer at 4.8 miles each way. A shorter option we will probably take is a new trail that starts right before we top out at the road.

We will leave the Pace Home (7087 Funkhouser Street, Bonners Ferry) at 8:00 AM, pick up Mike at the top of Peterson Hill at 8:10 AM and begin hiking from Shiloh at 8:30 AM. Shiloh Ranger Station is on Deep Creek between Naples and McArthur Lake. Shiloh Loop road is east of US Highway 95, and begins at the Naples Bridge and ends at McArthur Lake.
