

The seventeenth 2018 hike for our Selkirk Purcell Cabinet Club will be to Snow Lake on Wednesday August 22<sup>nd</sup>. We will leave the [Davidson Farm](#) at **9:00 AM** and return to the Farm around 2:30 PM. Snow Lake shares a trailhead with Bottleneck Lake, up the Snow Creek Road, 14.5 miles from the [Davidson Farm](#) (which is on the District One Dike Road 2.3 miles West from Bonners Ferry, one mile past the rock cut (outcropping), one mile before Deep Creek Bridge and two miles before the National Wildlife Refuge).

Snow Lake is a longer but easy 4-mile hike to a beautiful lake in a beautiful box canyon formed by Bottleneck Peak, Snow Peak and Snow Lake Peak.
