

Upper Priest River (John Loback) Hike | Selkirks

The nineteenth hike for the Selkirk, Cabinet Purcell Hikers this year will be Trail 308 Upper Priest River on Wednesday August 20th, 2014. Because it is such a long drive to northwestern Boundary County we actually drive half way (61 miles) to John Loback's home on Priest River the night before August 12th, and up to the trailhead (another 65 miles) Wednesday morning.
