

Blood Moons and Jewish Feasts

The purpose of this document is to define the greatest events in Jewish History. Tonight we will experience a Blood Moon. Because it also coincides with a Jewish feast, it is a [special Blood Moon](#). There have been only three of these Feast Blood Moons in the last 500 years. Blood Moons are red because the Earth is between the Sun and the Moon. The Bible indicates that great events in God's Story of his chosen people the Jews happen when signs like Blood Moons and Jewish Feasts coincide.

History of Signs

God defines the greatest events in his story using the alignment of the Sun, Moon, Planets, and Stars. I say Planets and Stars because of that other great event defined by the Star of Bethlehem (for details: see my short 2010 document [Meaning of the Stars](#)). The Bible contains several verses on signs from the heavens beginning with the statement in Genesis 1 that declares "signs" the first purpose of the heavenly bodies. [Genesis Chapter 1](#) ¹⁴ [And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years:](#) Then also in the Old Testament the Book of Joel defines Blood Moons as signs ([Joel 2:31](#)). The New Testament repeats this prophecy in Acts and expands on it in Revelation. Although rare, there have been many blood moons. But, when combined with the Feasts there have only been a few, each coinciding with great events in Jewish history. There were other great events in Jewish history, but I believe these three so far are by definition the greatest. In 1492 Columbus sailed the ocean blue, financed by rich Jews in Spain because those Jews were being expelled from Spain during the Inquisition. In May of 1948 (besides the great Flood in Bonners Ferry, causing me to be born in Spokane) the Jewish state of Israel was born. In 1967 the Israeli Jews captured Jerusalem in response to being attacked by their neighbors. In the next 100 years, there will only be one more of these Feast Day Blood Moons. Plus we are in season.

This Season

We are to know the season. There is only one more preliminary prophetic event to happen before the seven year tribulation. We recognize the four horsemen and their colors: Black for Capitalism, Red for Communism, White for the World's Religion, and Green (cloro, not pale) for Islamism. We know which country is represented by the bear, Russia; which country is represented by the Eagle, United States; which country is represented by the Lion, Great Britain; Which country is represented by the leopard, Germany; and which country is represented by the rooster, France. We know two of the three world wars have happened and the third has probably begun. We know Wormwood (Chernobyl) has happened. We know the Holy Roman Empire has been re-established. We know the West Bank has been given to the Palestinians. Only one prophecy left to happen, and we know for sure that signing of Peace in Jerusalem will commence the seven years before Armageddon and the Day of the Lord. Right now Secretary of State John Kerry is working on that peace. Until that peace

If God controls the heavenly bodies and his story like this, could he also control the weather? If we think we control the weather, are we worshipping ourselves? If we are worshipping the creation and not the creator, are we idol worshippers? History says idol worshippers torture those who refuse to worship their idols. If we non-violently stand up against idol worship, will we have our chance for martyrdom? Will our non-violent stance be accompanied by miracles, signs and wonders? Like in history, will many people be saved by witnessing those miracles? Will God give us the grace to stand? Will he give us the words to say? The answer is always yes.
