

Perfect Freedom

As I was reading his sermon [Christ the Believer's Husband](#), I realized I must write about the relationships that define perfect freedom; relationships between the heart, salvation, marriage and perfect freedom. Like my previous Faith Measurement documents have focused on heart change, George Whitfield has that focus for perfect freedom in this and many of his sermons.

Business Rules of Perfect Freedom

Perfect freedom is the result of heart change. Free of the Law of Sin and Death, God's Law (like business ethics) still helps us to perfect freedom. No matter what politics does to the definition of marriage, even if a right understanding of our Constitution (that includes our Declaration of Independence, therefore stating that our common law cannot conflict with his Biblical Law) even if that right understanding is unpopular, nobody or group of people can take away marriage, heart change and perfect freedom. Because these three things involve reverence and submission (to the extreme of even slavery) until people want perfect freedom, these things will always be unpopular. Male or female, we are all in the "same boat". We are all designed to be wives in a marriage. In other words, living in perfect freedom, doing exactly what we want to do, because we have a heart that has been changed by God, we all live as wives by Biblical marriage ethics. Once married to Jesus Christ, we no longer work for life, but we work from life enjoying perfect freedom. Once in life, God's Law lays out our wifely duties.
